Safety Guidelines:

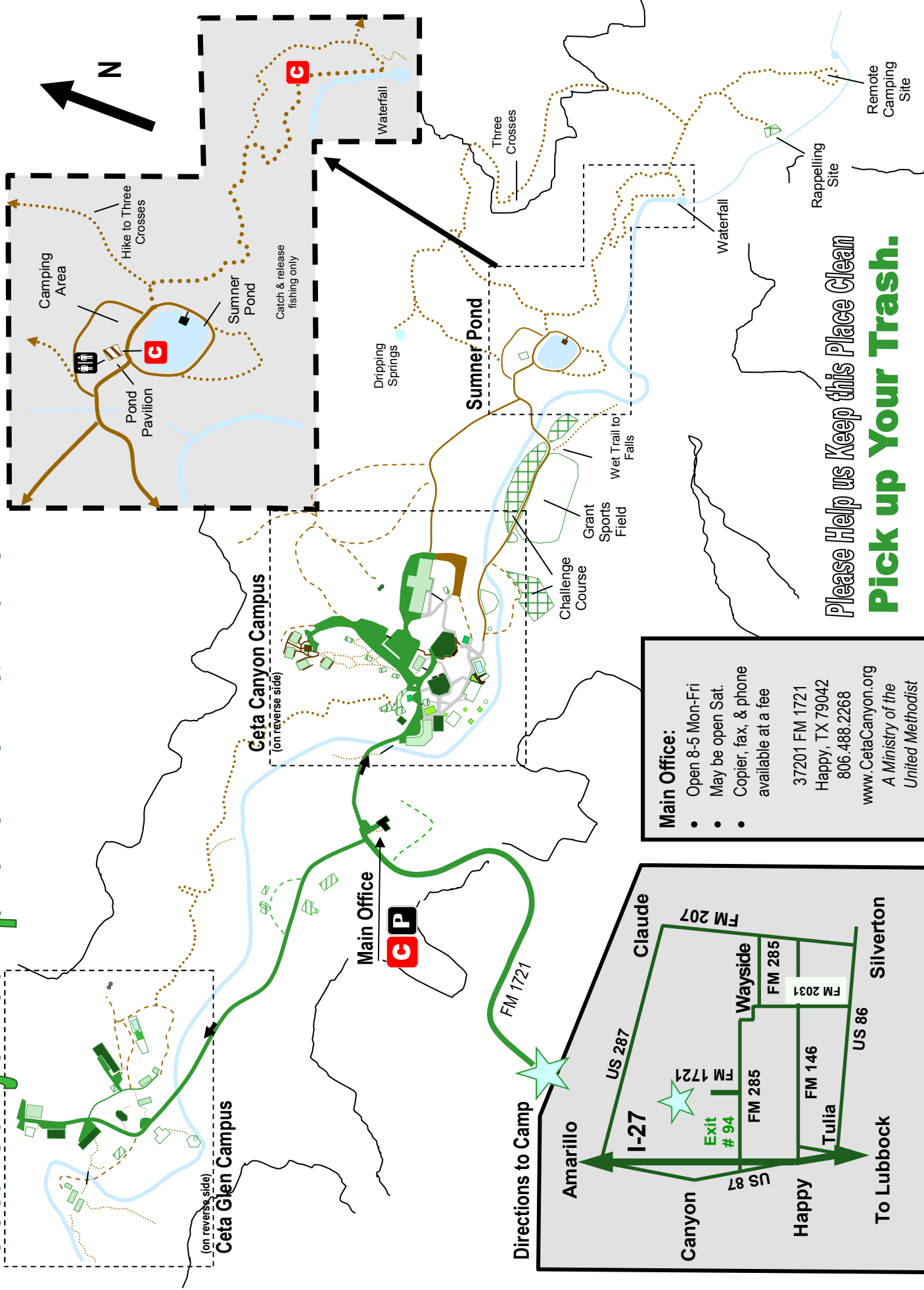
- No swimming in the pond, creek, or waterfall.

- Be careful hiking. Stay off the cliffs.
- Keep away from wildlife & report problems to staff.
- Hike in groups of at least 3.
- The south rim, including the lighted cross on the Ceta side is private property. Please stay off
- Do not cross any fencing.
- Firearms, fire-works, alcoholic beverages, and the unlawful use of drugs are not allowed.
- Smoking is not allowed in any of the buildings.
- Pets, except for service animals, are not allowed.
- No rollerblades, skates, skateboards, bikes, etc.

In Emergencies:

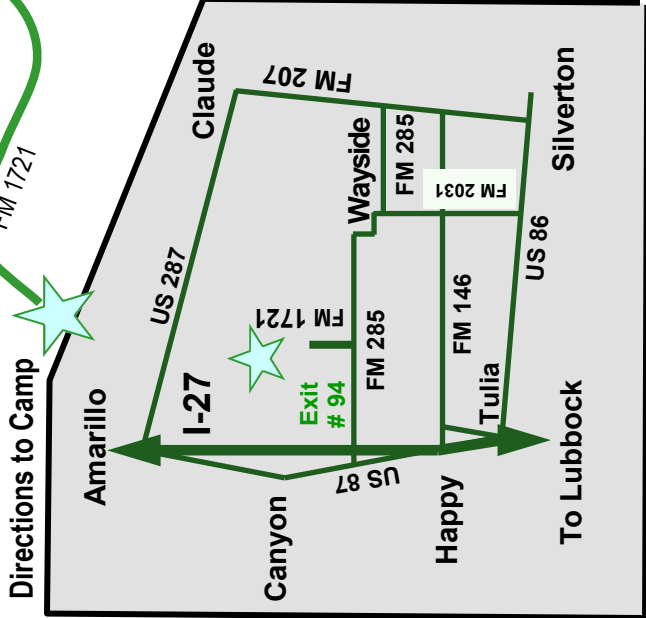
- Use a call box to contact Ceta Canyon Staff.

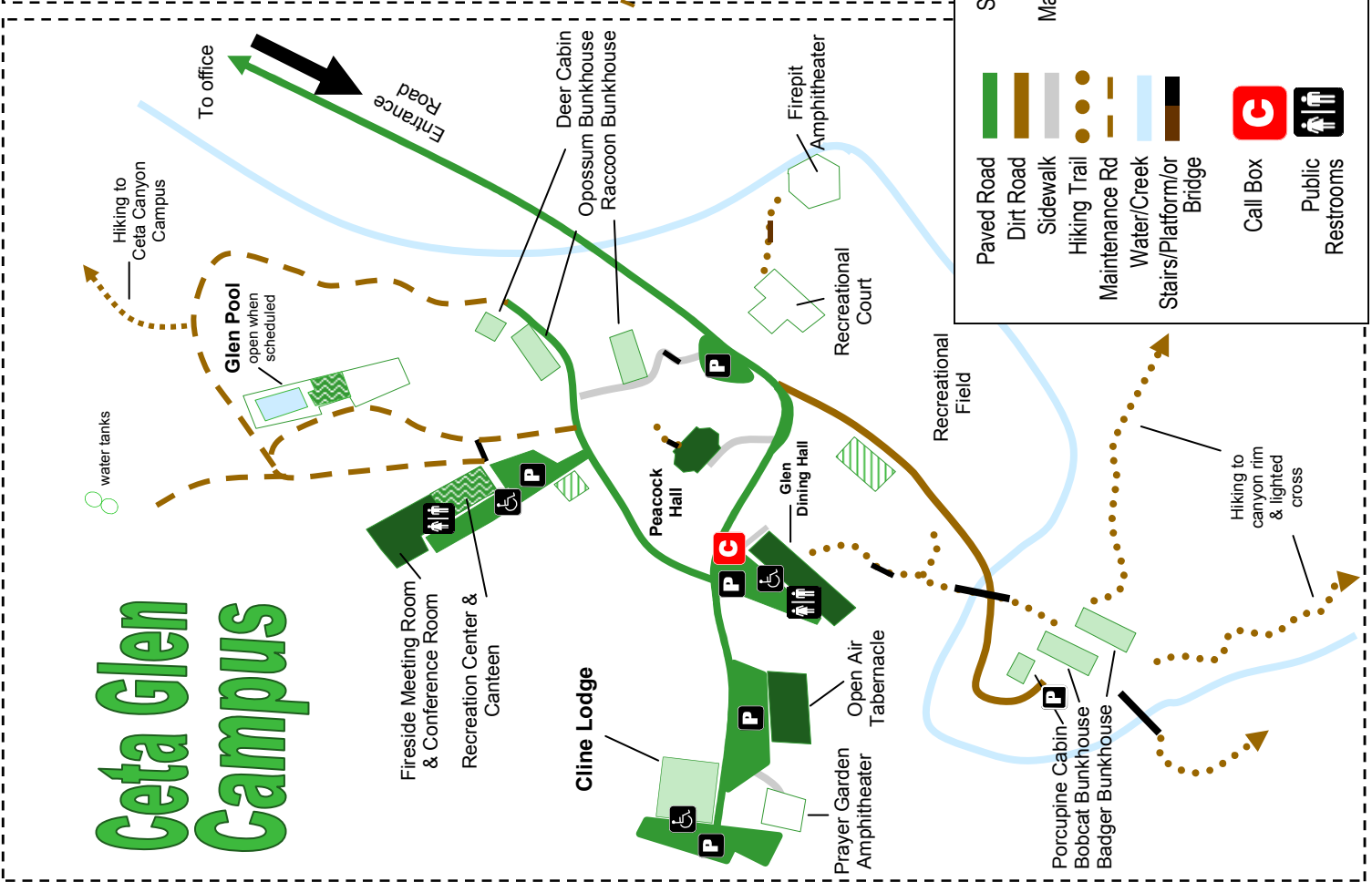
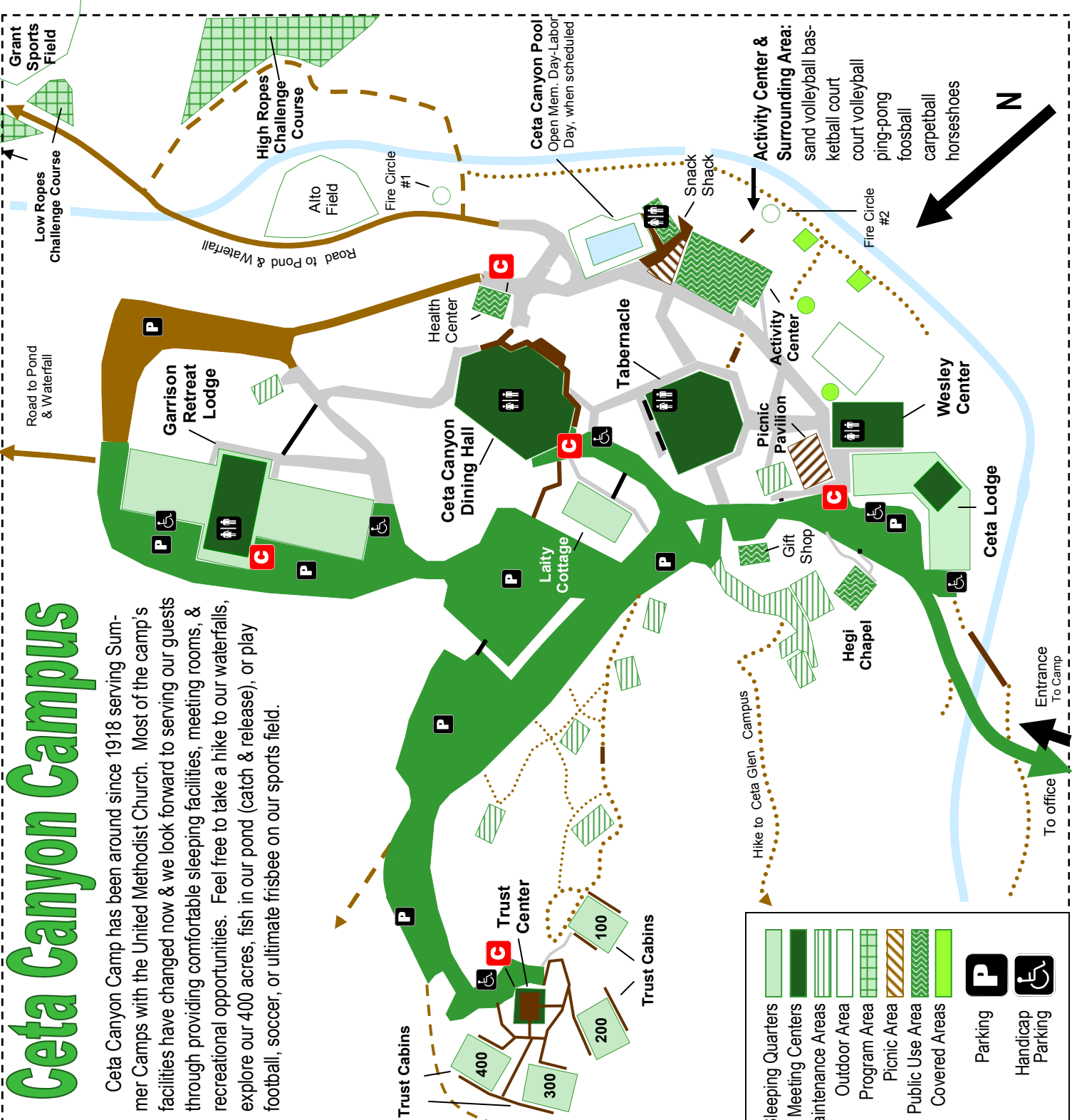
